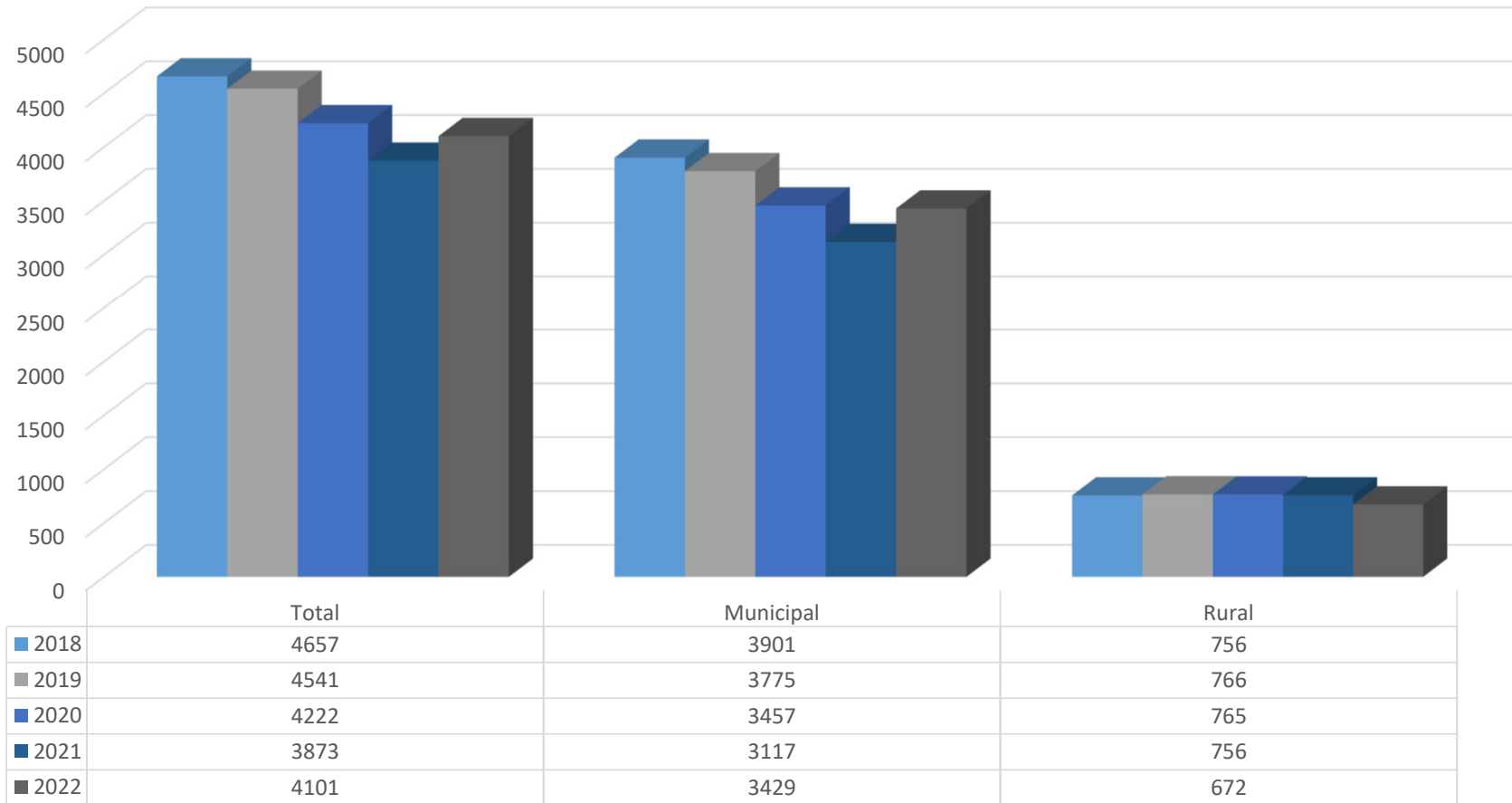

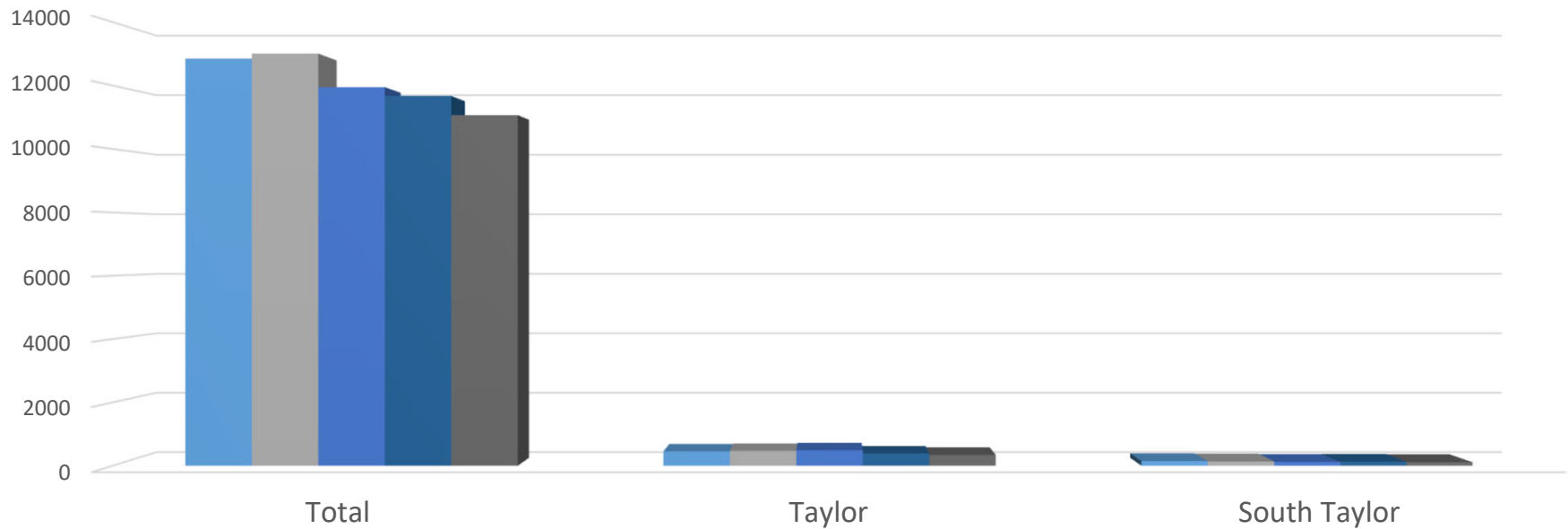


Total Criminal Code Call Comparison





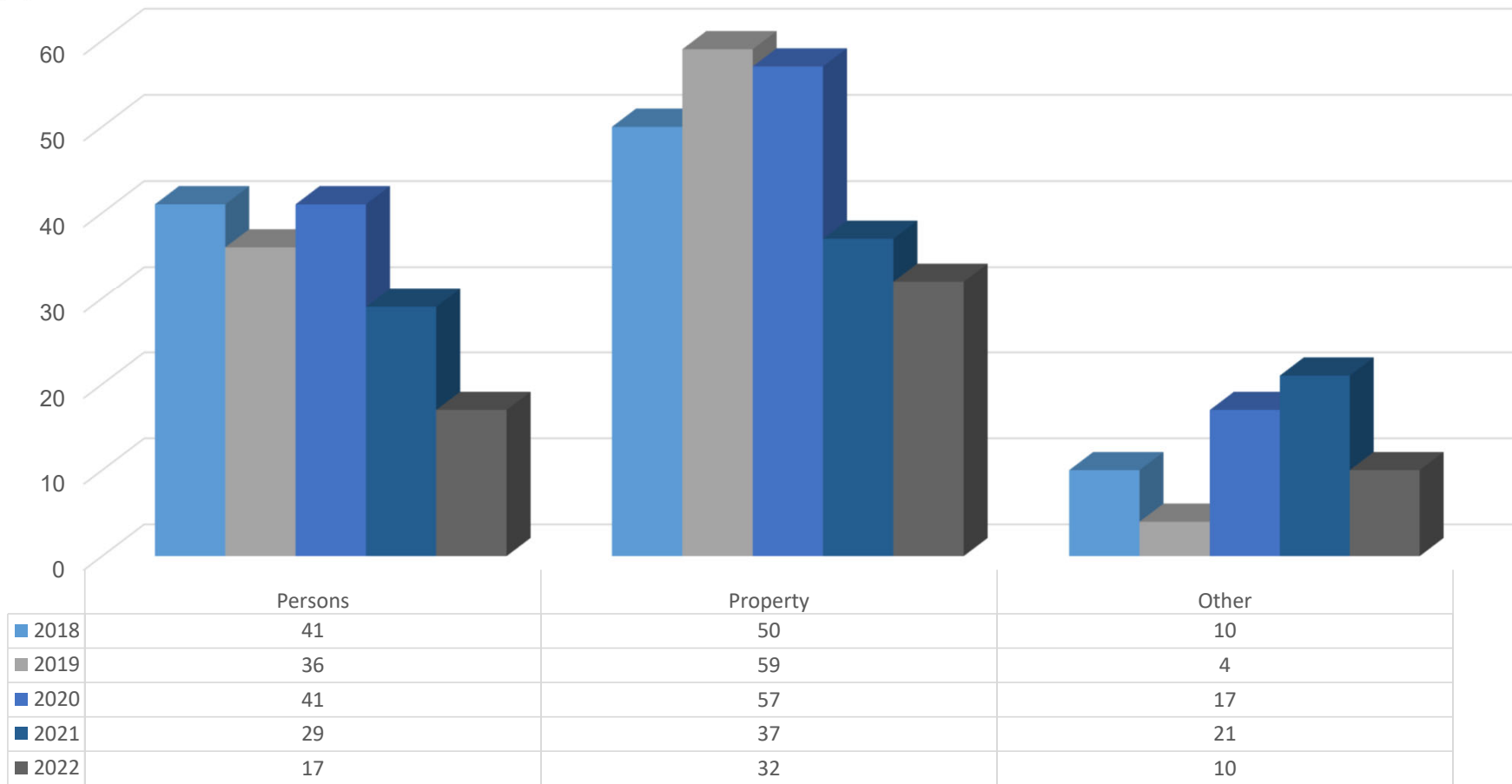

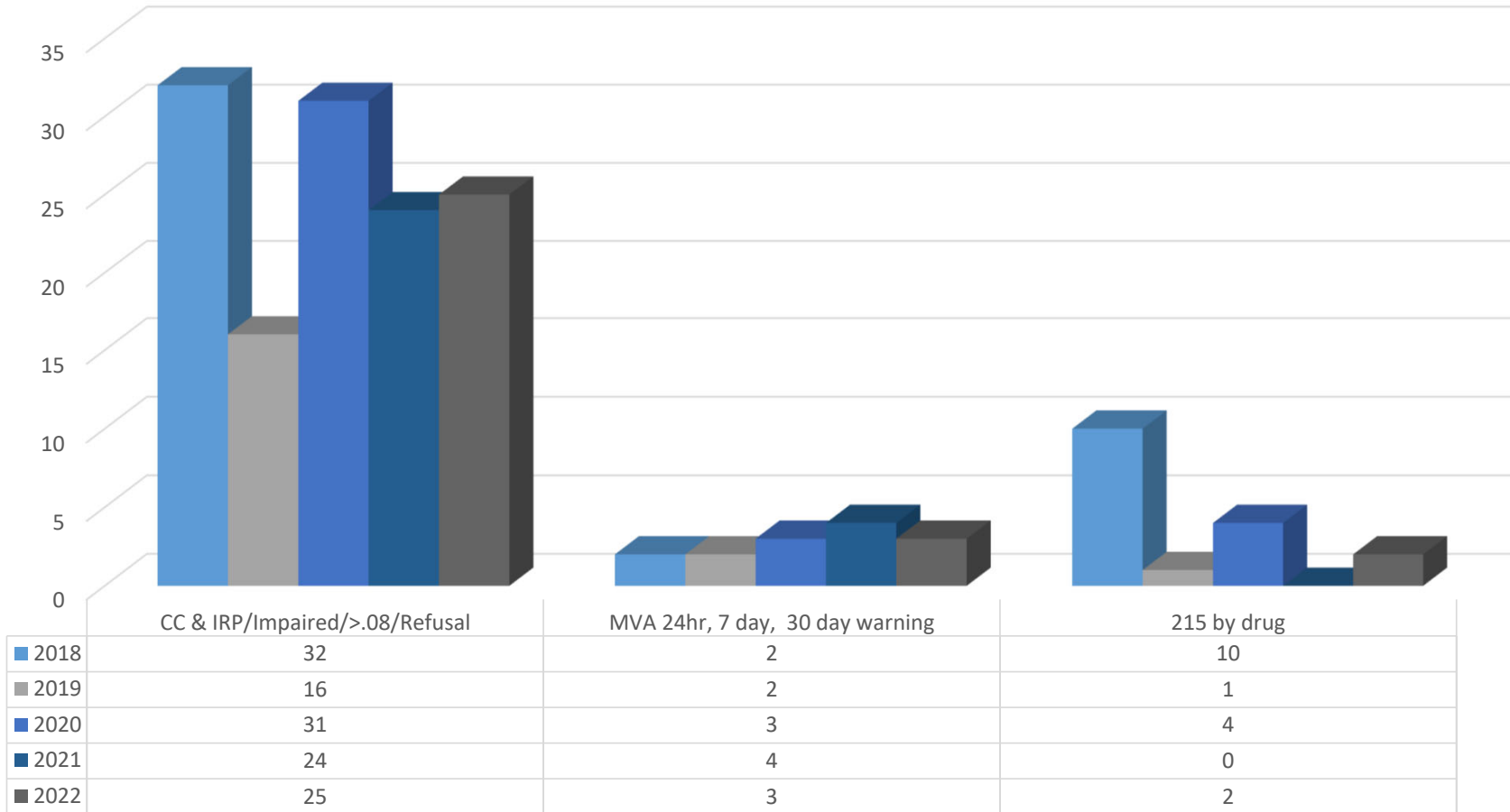


Taylor - Criminal Code Offenses



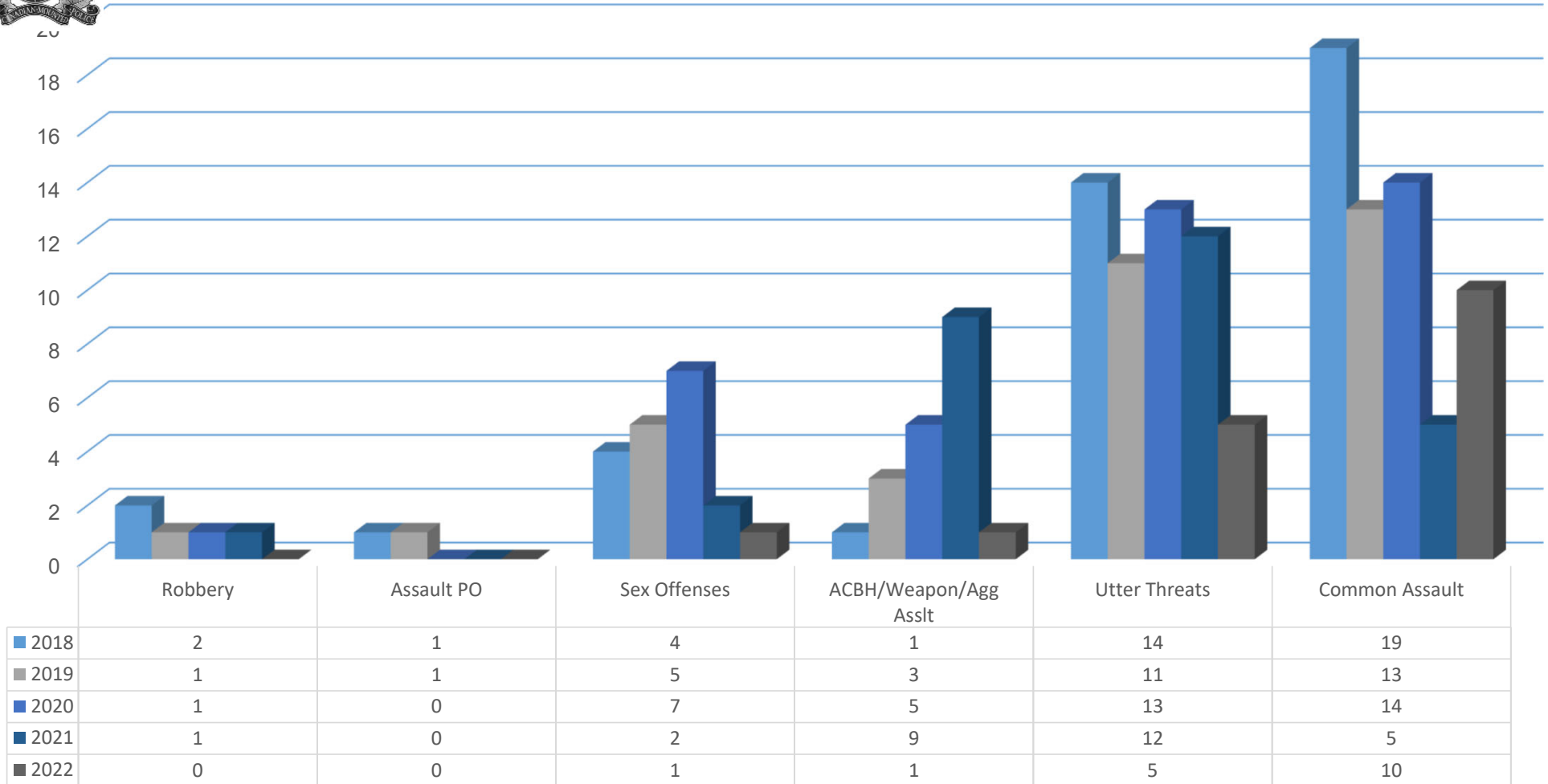


Taylor - Impaired Drivers



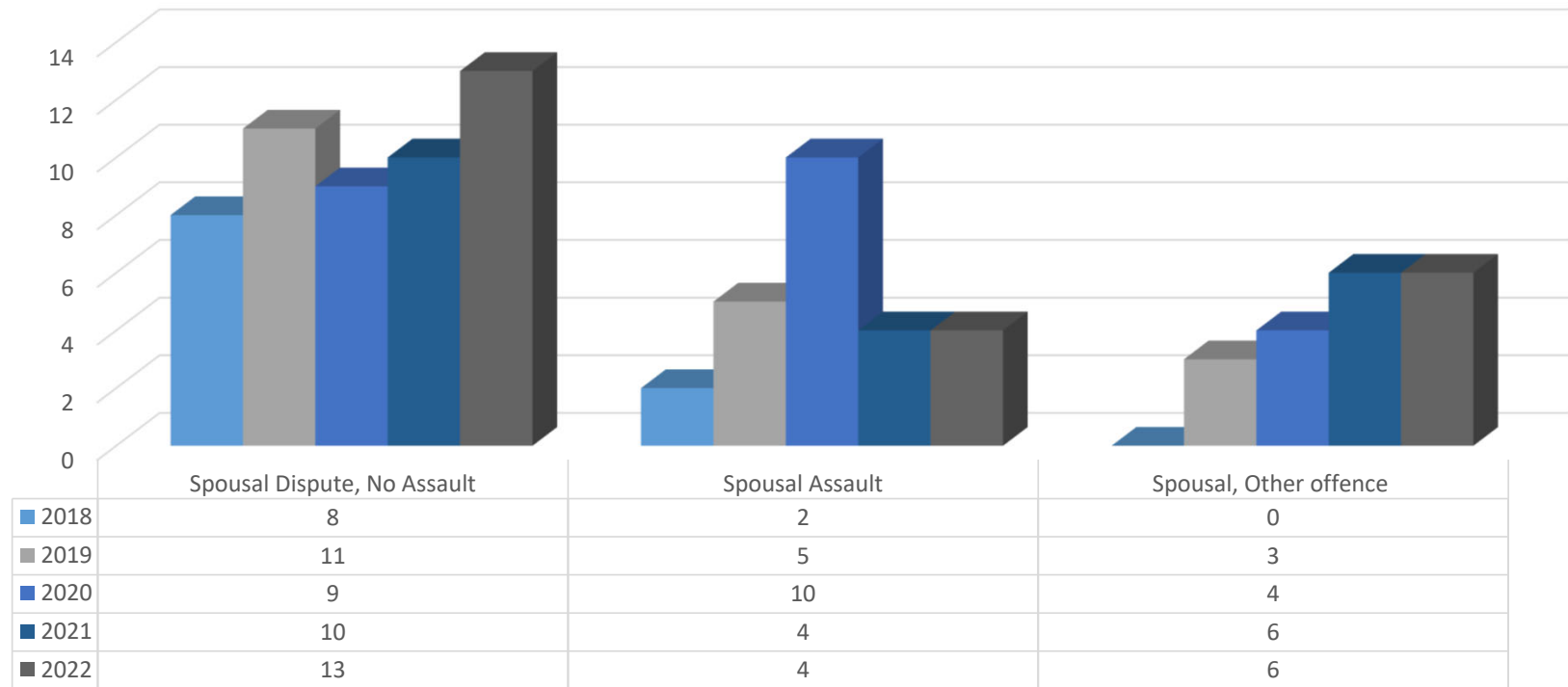


Taylor - Persons (Violent) Crimes



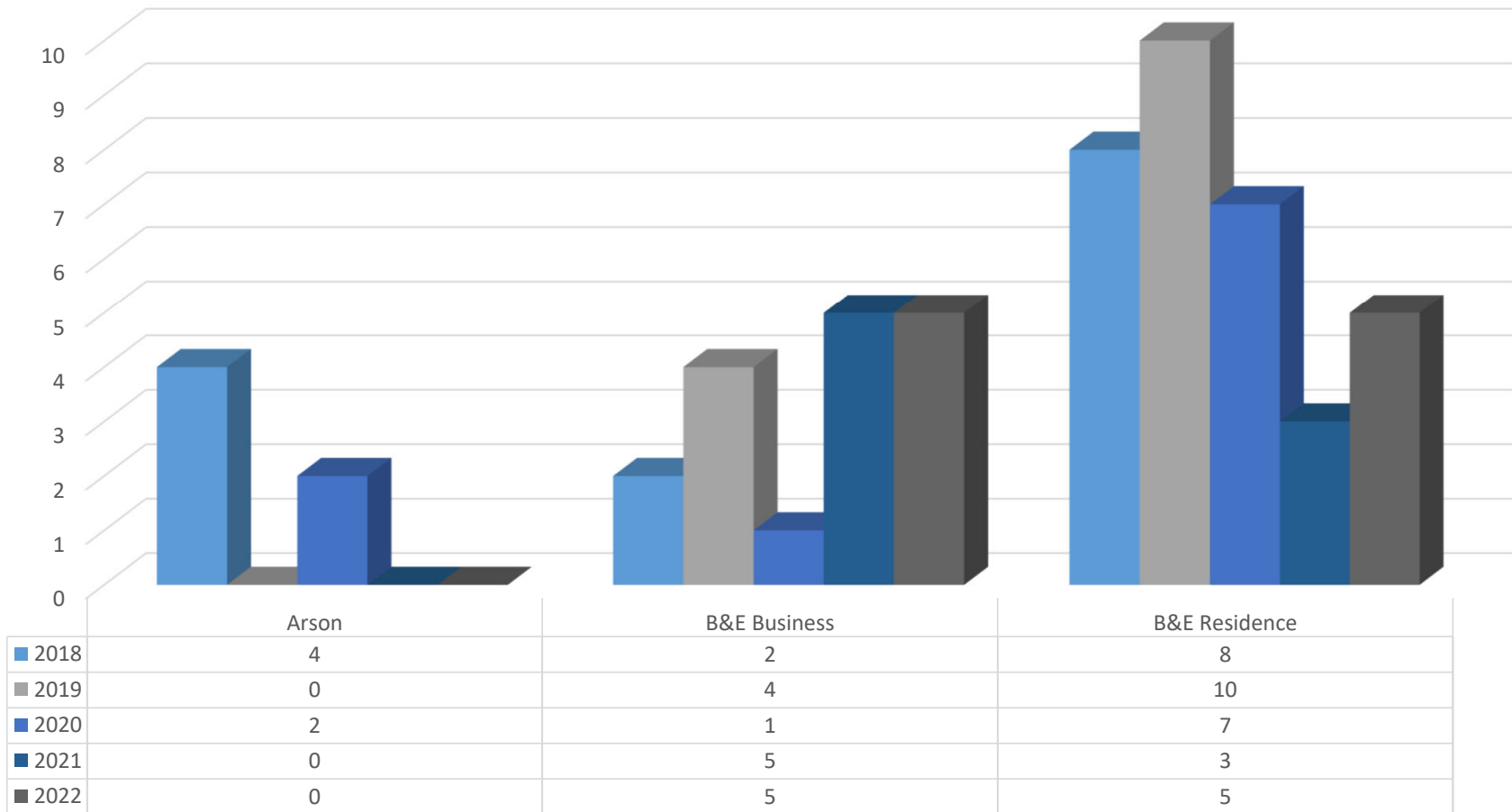


Taylor – Violence in Relationships



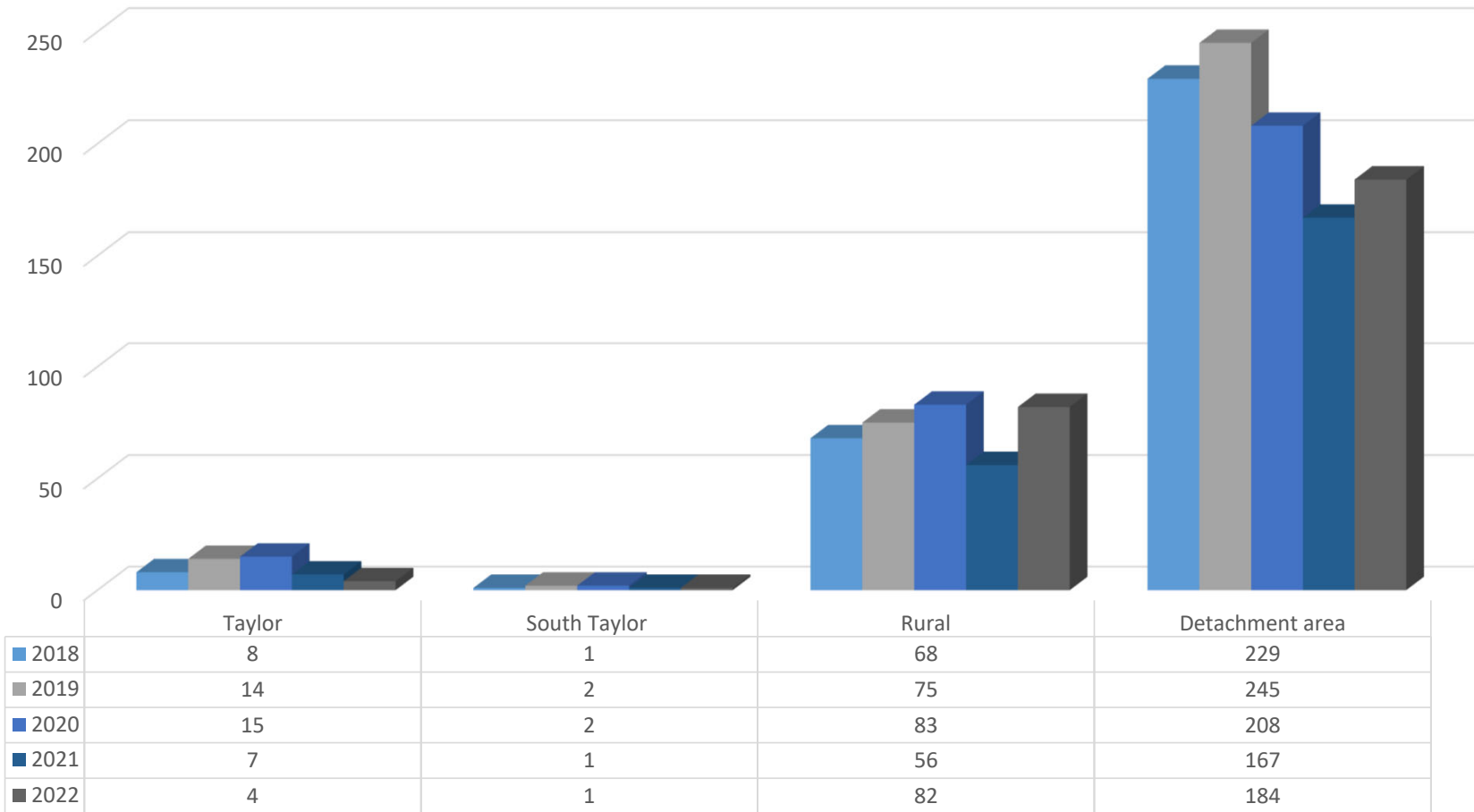


Taylor - Property Crimes



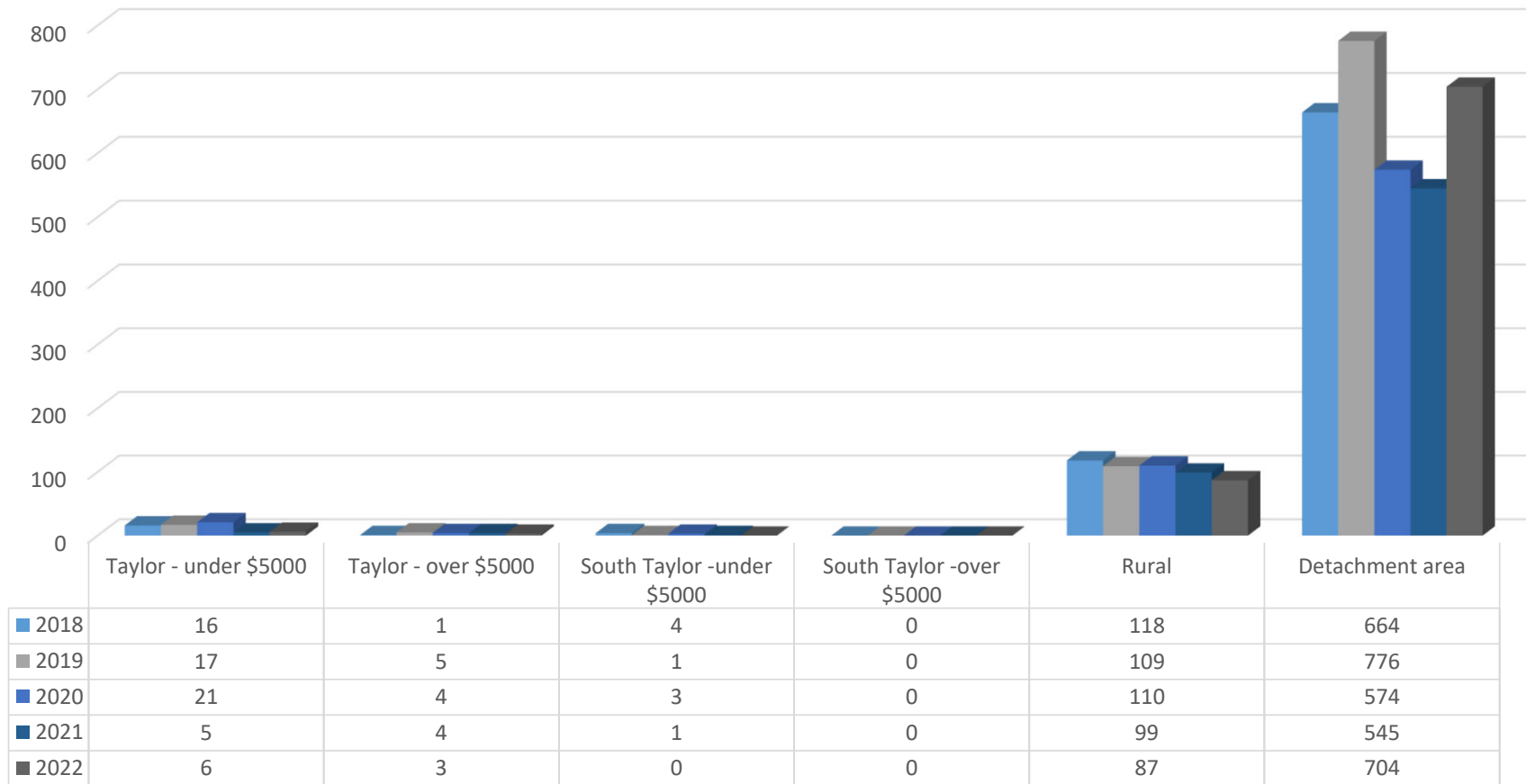


Taylor - Vehicle Thefts



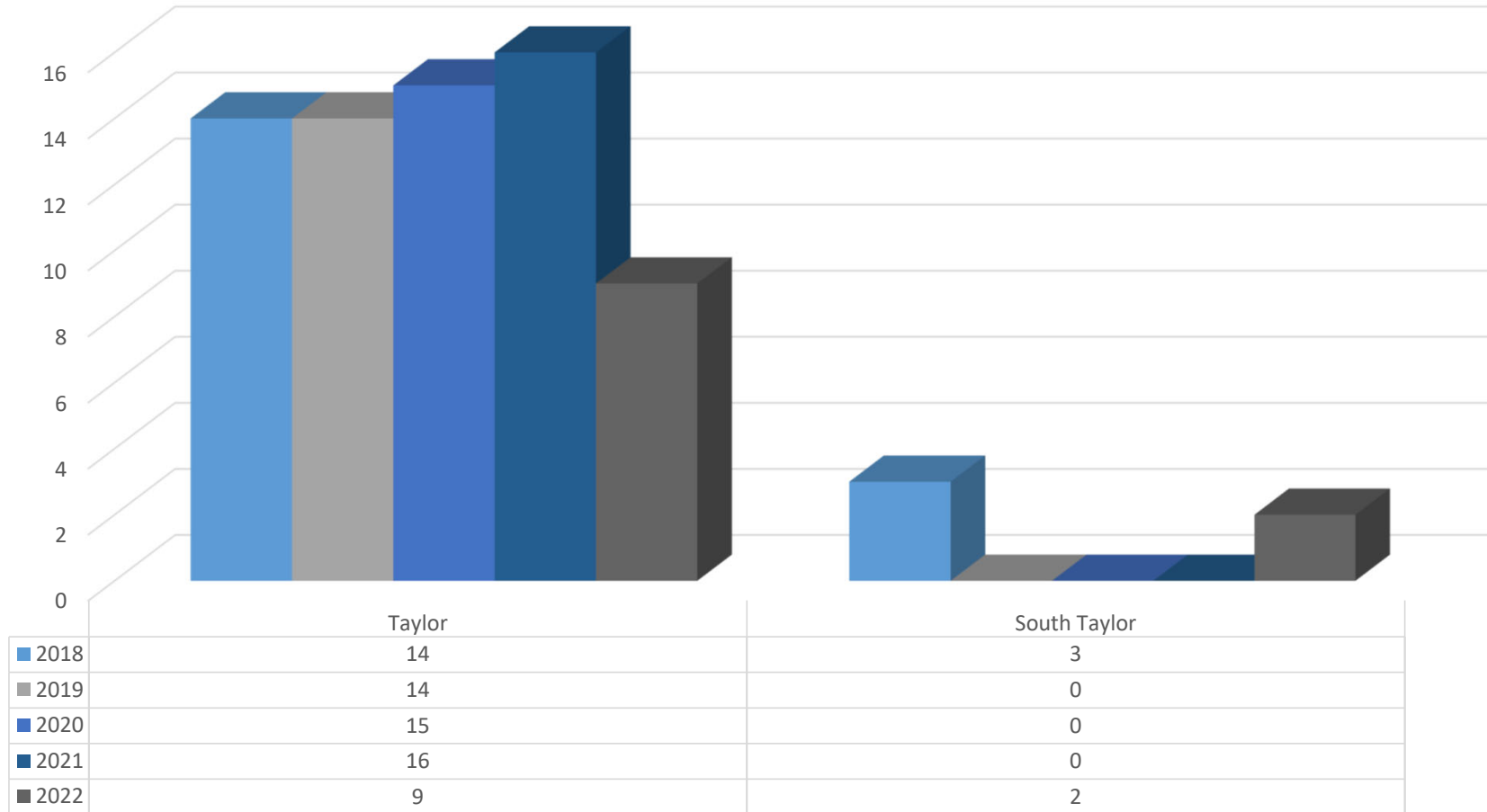


Taylor – Theft, all types



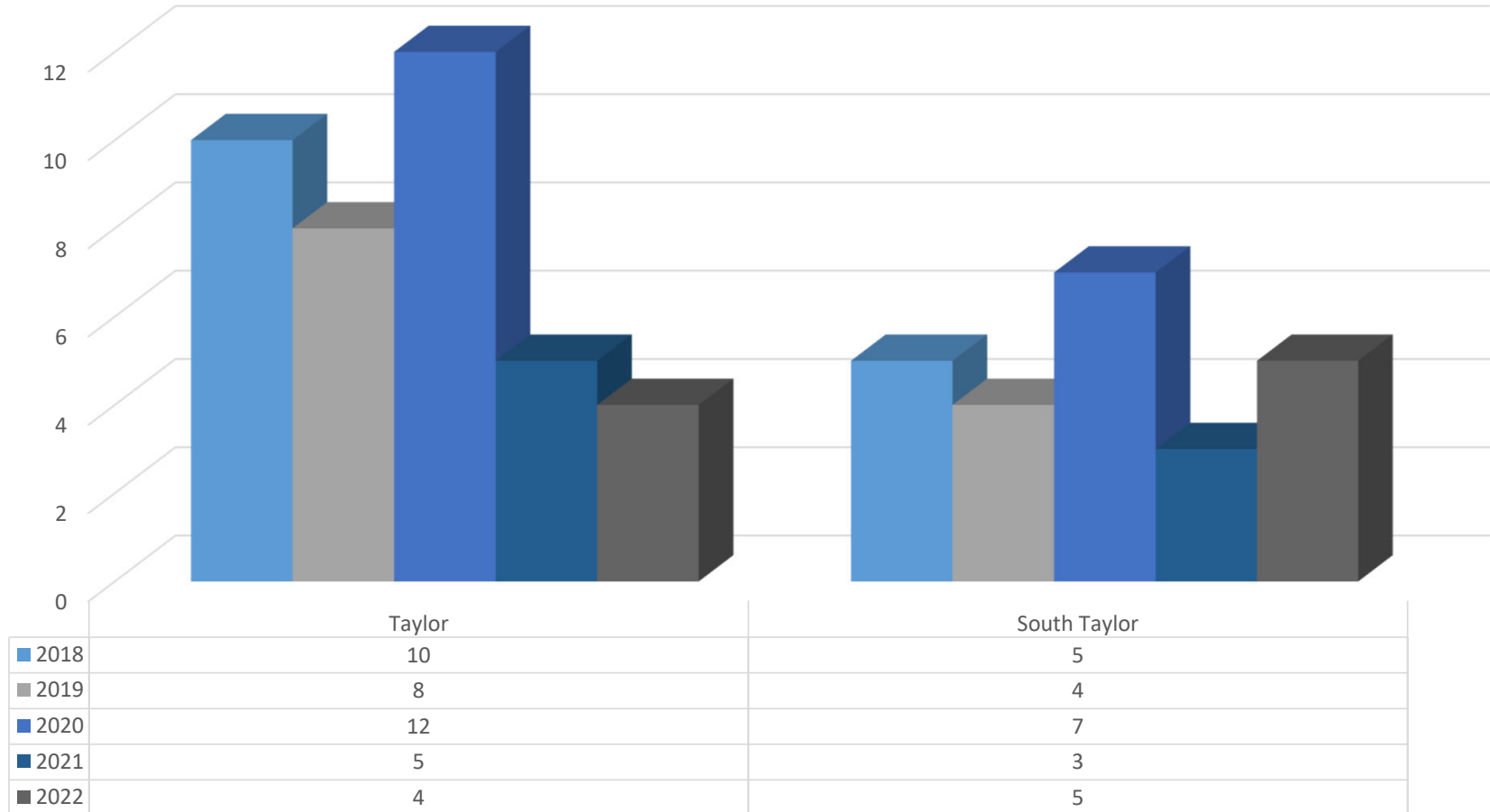


Taylor – Mischief to Property



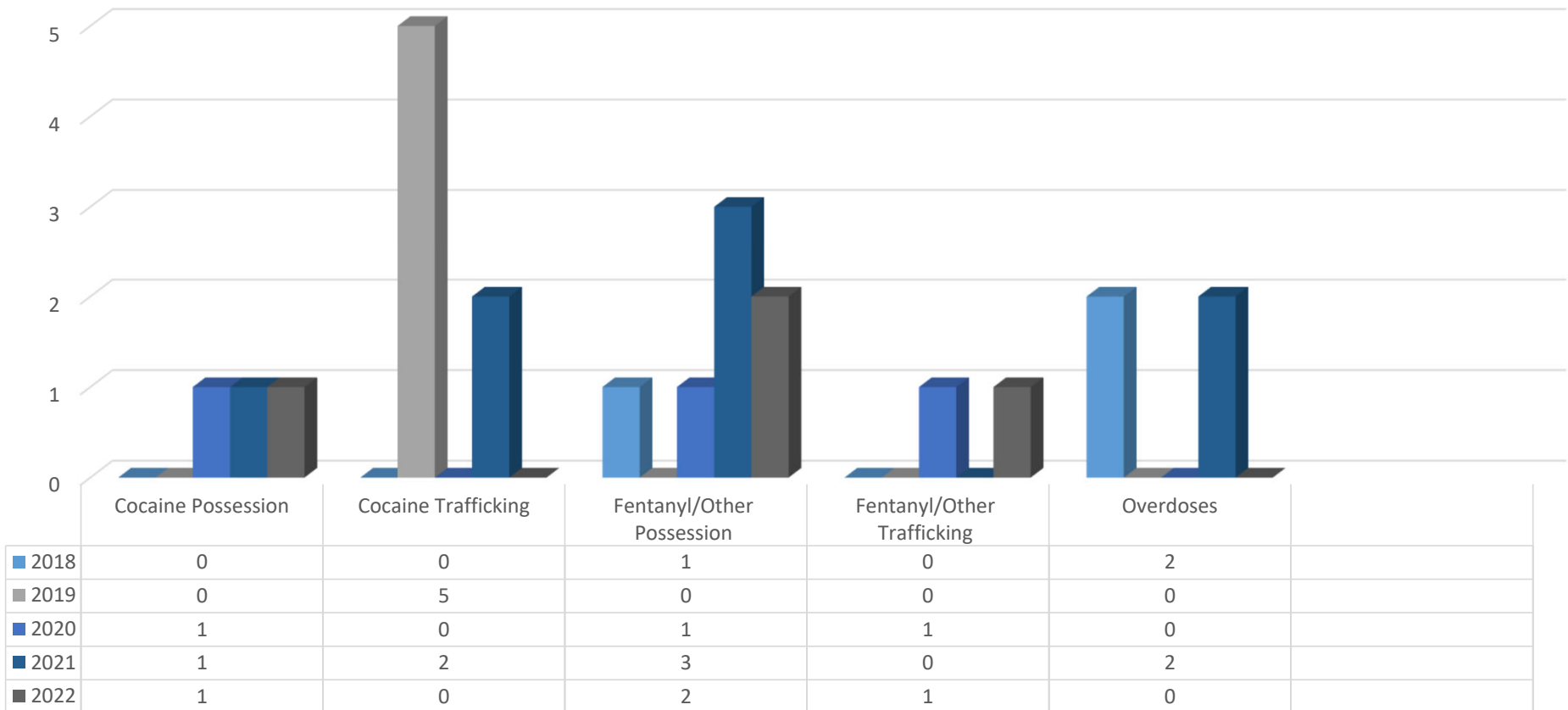


Taylor - Public Disturbances



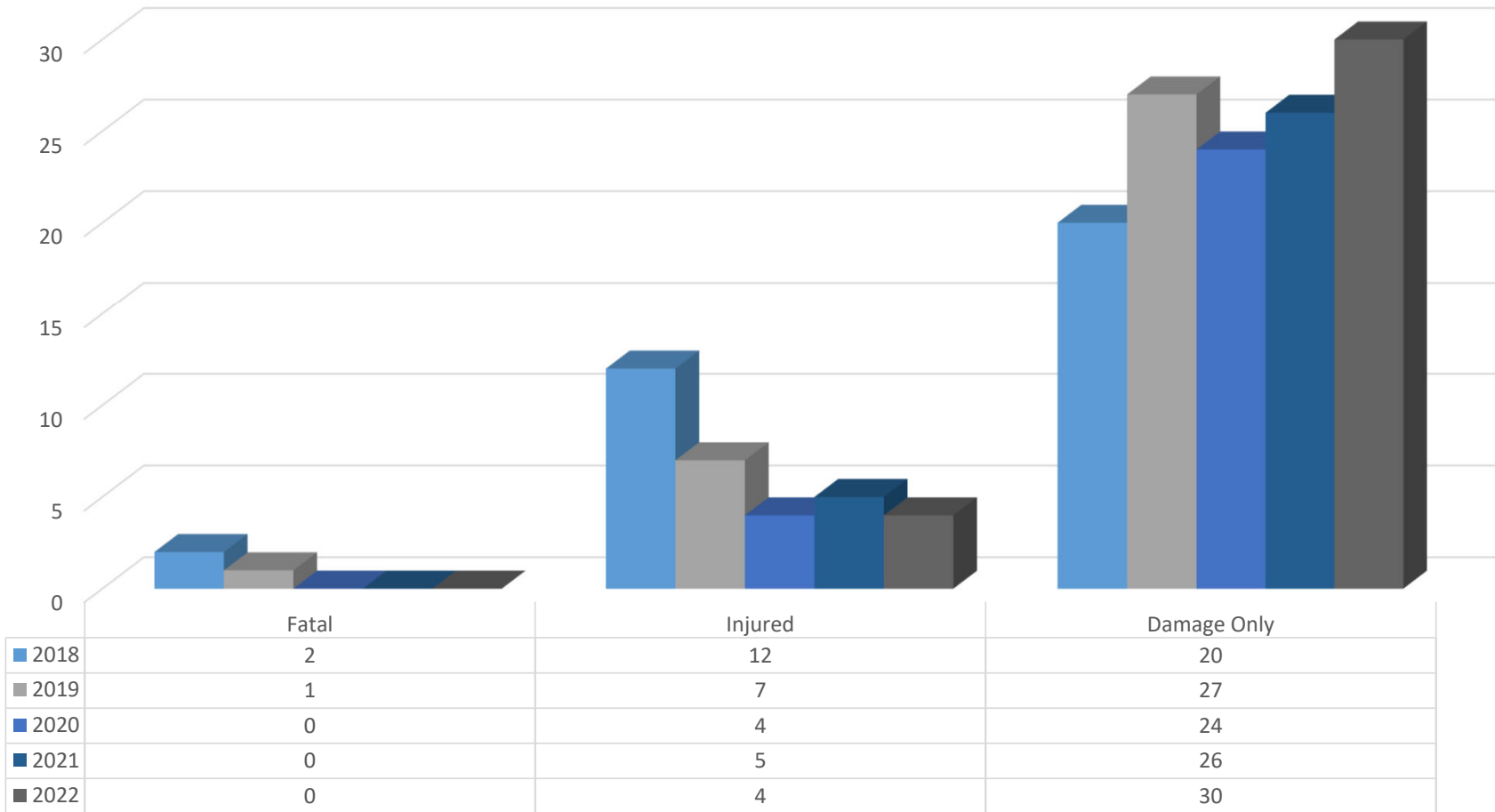


Taylor - Controlled Drug and Substances Act



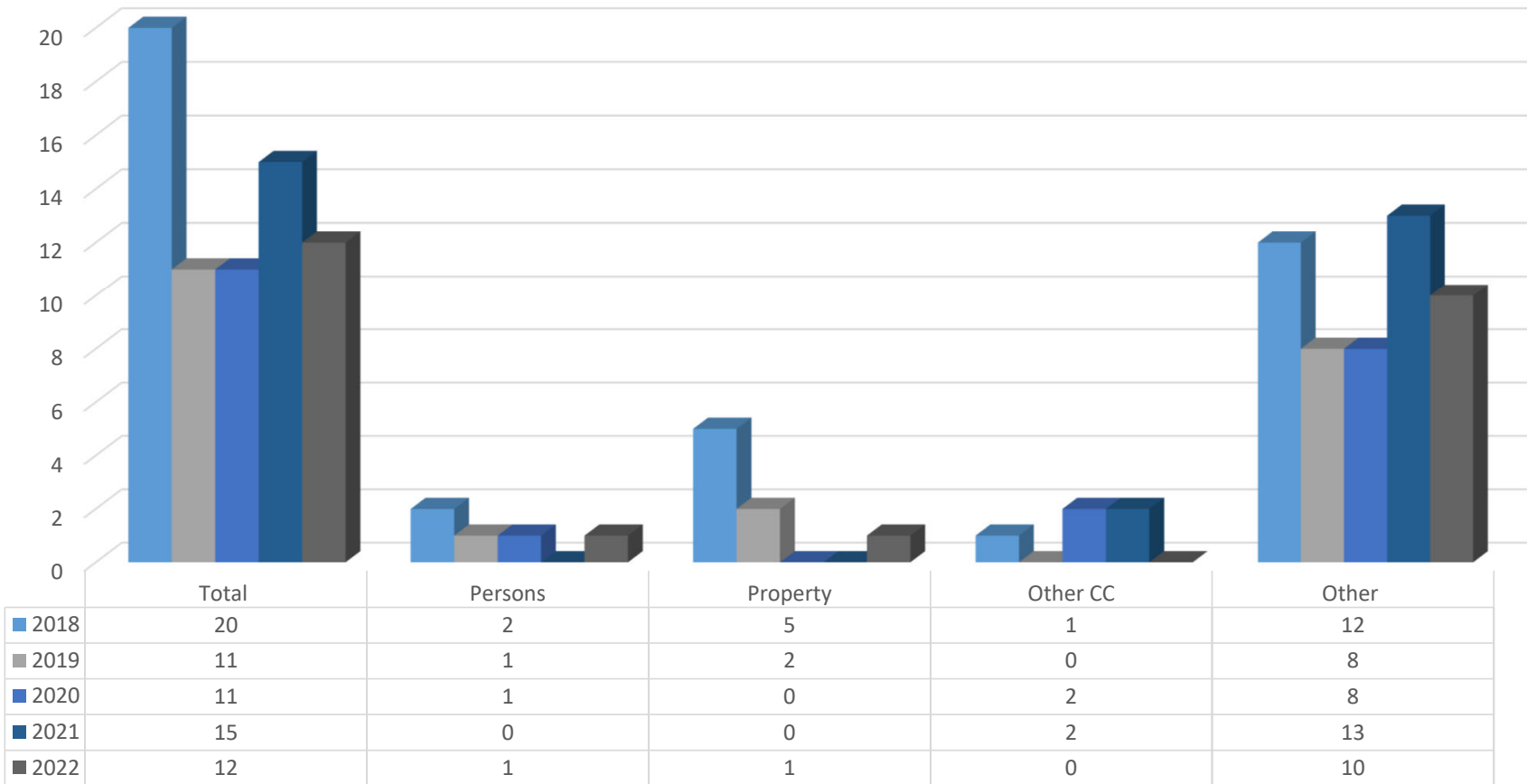


Taylor - Motor Vehicle Incidents



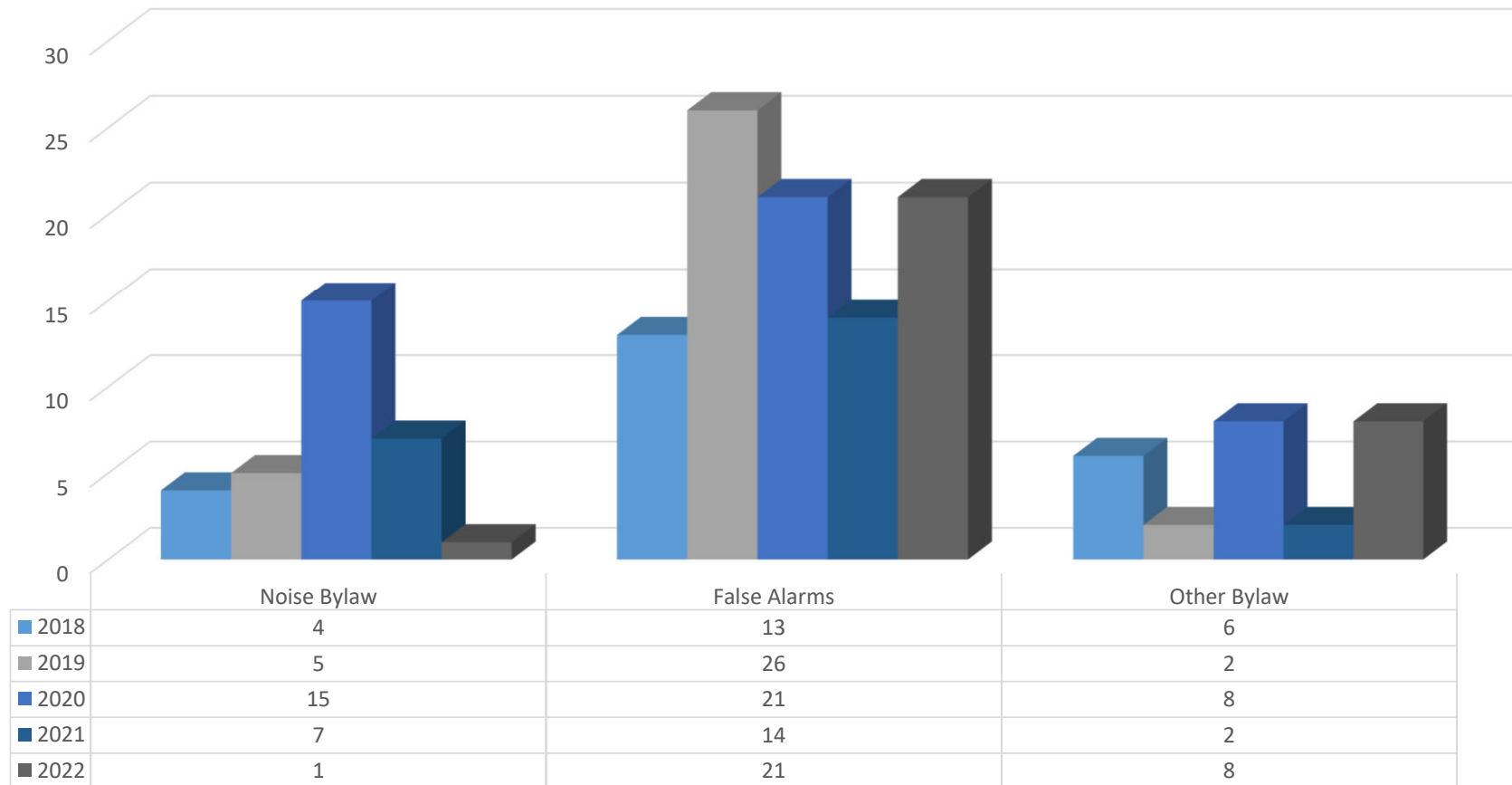
