### **July 2025 Policing Report**

The following information is provided as the July 2025 Fort St John Detachment update on crime statistics, police activity, and new developments within the detachment operations and administration.

#### **DETACHMENT RESOURCE REPORTING**

For the month of July 2025, the detachment is operating with 5 x SOFT (temporary) vacancy and 5 hard vacancies which include:

- 3 members are off duty sick, 2 members are on Parental leave, 1 member is on administrative leave.
- 2 Serious Crime Constable positions are vacant, 1 position vacant in municipal traffic and 2 are vacant in general duty.
- 2 experienced members have been selected to fill the 2 vacant serious crime constable positions and are expected in the fall,
- 1 experienced member will be incoming in September to front line policing.

#### **CRIME TREND REPORTING**

This month saw a significant downturn in Theft from Motor Vehicles, from 36 to 11.

Shoplifting is also down from 20 files in June to 11. Reported incidents of theft under \$5000 has however increased from 17 incidents in June to 27 in July.

There were no other significant changes in the other commonly reported on statistics.
